It also includes the number of SSI/SSP Interim Assistance cases added or denied during the month, and SSA checks disposed of during the month. County revisions for current and prior years are anticipated for this report. Please check the site regularly for updated data.</p>
CA 1037	<p>Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants Monthly Caseload Movement Statistical Report</p> <p>This monthly report includes data on the number of Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI) applications received, requests for restorations, and applications approved or denied. It includes the number of cases approved, restored, and discontinued for Qualified, Non-Qualified and Sponsored Aliens. It also includes the number of recipients paid during the month.</p>
SOC 808	<p>Quarterly Report of Overpayments and Collections for CAPI</p> <p>This quarterly report includes data on notices sent, overpayment cases transferred to and from other counties as well as cases waived, not pursued, and fully recovered for CAPI.</p>
ABCD 350	<p>Annual Recipient Report</p> <p>This annual report includes data on the ethnic origins and primary languages of recipients of CalWORKs, Foster Care, Social Services, Non-Assistance CalFresh, CalWORKs Welfare-to-Work (WtW), Refugee Cash Assistance, and CAPI.</p>

CF 18	<p>CalFresh Churn Monthly Report</p> <p>The CalFresh Churn Monthly Caseload Report (CF 18) captures data regarding CalFresh “caseload churn”, including the total number of CalFresh households scheduled to submit a Semi-Annual Report (SAR 7) and Redetermination/Recertification/Reapplication (RRR) within a given month and whether the scheduled SAR 7 or RRR is submitted timely, untimely, late, or is not renewed. This report also includes data on SAR 7- and RRR-related discontinuances, as well as the average days to process (ADP) initial and non-initial applications for both expedited and non-expedited service.</p>
CF 296	<p>CalFresh Monthly Caseload Movement Statistical Report</p> <p>The monthly CF 296 report contains data on the number of CalFresh applications received, approved, denied, and withdrawn. This includes data on the number of CalFresh applications processed under expedited service, processing timeframes and discontinuances due to recipients' failure to complete the application process for ongoing CalFresh benefits. The report also includes the number of cases eligible; Inter-County Transfers received; restoration of prorated benefits; recertifications disposed of and the number of overdue recertifications during the month.</p>
DFA 256	<p>Food Stamp Program Participation and Benefit Issuance Report</p> <p>This monthly report includes data on the number of Food Stamp Public Assistance and Non-Public Assistance households and persons participating in the federal and state Food Stamp programs; the number of issuances provided by mail and contracted over the counter; and the value of documented coupon issuances.</p>
DFA 358F	<p>CalFresh Participants by Race/Ethnicity - Federal-Only and Combined Households</p> <p>This annual report includes data on the number of Federal and Federal/State combined households participating in CalFresh during the month of July by race/ethnicity and assistance status.</p>
DFA 358S	<p>CalFresh Participants by Race/Ethnicity - State-Only Households</p> <p>This annual report includes data on the number of State-only households participating in CalFresh during the month of July by race/ethnicity and assistance status.</p>
STAT 47	<p>Non-Assistance CalFresh Work Registrants, Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWD), and Employment and Training (E&T) Program Quarterly Statistical Report</p> <p>This quarterly report includes data on California's Non-Assistance CalFresh recipients: monthly caseload data, the ABAWD population, and the work registrant population both in county-administered E&T programs and non-E&T counties.</p>
WINS 2	<p>Work Incentive Nutritional Supplement (WINS) Monthly Caseload Report</p> <p>This monthly report includes data about the WINS program. The WINS program provides a ten dollars (\$10) per month additional food supplement benefit for each WINS-eligible CalFresh and California Food Assistance Program household. The monthly WINS report includes data on the number of CalFresh Public Assistance and Non-Public Assistance households and persons participating in the federal and state CalFresh programs; the number of issuances provided by Electronic Benefit Transfer; and the value of documented benefit issuances.</p>

CA 237	<p>CalWORKs Cash Grant Caseload Movement Report</p> <p>This monthly report includes data on CalWORKs caseload movement for Two Parent Families, Zero Parent Families, All Other Families, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Timed-Out, Safety Net, Fleeing Felon and Long-Term Sanction cases. This report includes data on applications requested or restored, the number of cases added during the month, the number of cases exiting during the month, and the number of cases transferred from other counties during the month.</p>
CA 253	<p>CalWORKs Report on Reasons for Discontinuances of Cash Grant</p> <p>This monthly report includes data on the number of CalWORKs cases discontinued from the cash grant program for Two Parent Families, Zero Parent Families, All Other Families, TANF Timed-Out, Safety Net, Fleeing Felon and Long-Term Sanction cases. The report includes reasons for discontinuance of these cases, and data on the movement of cases within the specific family segments in the CalWORKs program.</p>

It also includes those enrollees who have been exempted from these employment requirements, those who have been sanctioned for failure to comply with the mandates, and those who have been terminated from employment components due to time limits and due to employment obtained during the month.</p>
WTW 25A	<p>CalWORKs Welfare-To-Work Monthly Activity Report - Two-Parent Families</p> <p>This monthly report includes the number of Two-Parent Families who are enrolled in mandatory WtW employment-preparation activities. It also includes those enrollees who have been exempted from these employment requirements, those who have been sanctioned for failure to comply with the mandates, and those who have been terminated from employment components due to time limits and due to employment obtained during the month.</p>
CA 237 HA	<p>CalWORKs Homeless Assistance Program Monthly Statistical Report</p> <p>This monthly report provides county, state, and federal entities with information needed for budgeting staffing, program planning, and other purposes. The data also includes the number and type of FS services received at a case and person level.</p>
CW 115	<p>Child Care Monthly Report - CalWORKs Families</p> <p>This monthly report includes data on the number of CalWORKs families and children approved/authorized/certified to receive Stage 1 childcare during the report month. The data are broken out by the families' participation in the WtW or Cal-Learn Programs, those who were No Longer on Aid, or those who have timed out of their 60-month eligibility (CalWORKs Safety Net Program). Beginning with the July 2015 report month, the CW 115 report changed its focus to childcare received to reflect caseload data more accurately.</p>
CW115A	<p>Child Care Monthly Report - Two-Parent Families</p> <p>This monthly report includes data on the number of Two Parent families and children approved/authorized/certified to receive Stage 1 childcare during the report month. The data are broken out by the families' participation in the WtW or Cal-Learn Programs, those who were No Longer on Aid, or those who have timed out of their 60-month eligibility (CalWORKs Safety Program). Beginning with the July 2015 report month, the CW 115A report changed its focus to childcare received, rather than payments received to reflect caseload data more accurately.</p>
